Sprinkling Rite During Easter

By the time you read this article we will be well into the
great 50 days of the Easter Season. During the Sunday
celebration of the Eucharist we will be using the Sprinkling
Rite in place of the Act of Penitence (GIRM 51). The
Sprinkling Rite, used during the Easter Season, calls to mind
our union with the Death and Resurrection of Jesus. In this rite
we can see an abundant use of water that signifies God's
overflowing love and mercy. It is a visual reminder of
Baptism and the unique character of Sunday. As in the
Sacrament of Baptism, there are many levels that come into
play. The water is new life, the cleansing and forgiveness of
sin, God's saving deeds and protection from evil. In the
Liturgy, water is used to baptize and incorporate one into
the Body of Christ. After the Sprinkling Rite, we sing the
"Glory to God" and the Priest says the "Opening Prayer"
and then move into the Liturgy of the Word. Here is where
we begin to do what we are called to do as "baptized
people" listening to God's Word, offering prayers for the
needs of all, giving thanks, praising and sharing in the Body
and Blood of Christ. Then, we are sent forth to share the
Good News of Jesus.

EMBRACING A GENEROUS LIFE OF STEWARDSHIP

Second Sunday of Easter/Sunday of Divine Mercy. Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." With those words of comfort, Jesus reaches out to us across the chasm of time. This is not only the Second Sunday of Easter, but also Divine Mercy Sunday. Divine Mercy Sunday is a relatively recent development within the Church, having been established by Pope John Paul II the year 2000. Today is also a monumental day in the history of our Church as Pope John Paul II and Pope John XXIII will be canonized and become St. John Paul II and St. John XXIII, respectively. The readings for this Sunday are replete with forgiveness and love. In the first reading from Acts we hear about the earliest days of the Church, how the Apostles and other followers of Jesus banded together to support and to help one another. In the second reading, the beginning of Peter's first letter to those followers throughout what is now Turkey, St. Peter speaks of the mercy of the Lord to us through salvation. However, he cautions us that following Jesus is not and will not be trouble-free. The Gospel from John relates also the beginnings of the Church. By bestowing the Holy Spirit upon His followers ("He breathed on them and said 'Receive the Holy Spirit'"), Jesus made them the first stewards of the Church. We, too, are stewards of the Church. In their Pastoral Letter on Stewardship (Stewardship: A Disciple's Response) our U.S. Bishops declared, "We are all stewards of the Church." With Easter so fresh to us, now is the time to accept that responsibility. -

Renewing God's House-Capital Campaign Fund Update

St. Bernard Building & Grounds Committee has received approval from the St. Bernard Finance Council to replace the roof over the Office and Classrooms at a price of \$106,000 and an additional \$71,689 to upgrade, repair and or replace exterior doors. These two projects are being funded from the Renewing God's House Fund. Our current balance in our Renewing God's House Fund is \$292,177. These projects are expected to be completed this spring/summer. A third project proposed by the Building & Grounds Committee and was approved, is the replacement of the brick surrounding the support beams in the Carport Area. The Carport Area will be safe to drive through as the supporting beams are in place and will not be affected by the brick work. More details will follow as projects get underway.
