## EMBRACING A GENEROUS LIFE OF STEWARDSHIP

On the day of His Resurrection Christ appeared to others on five occasions. It is worth noting that the story of the empty tomb appears in all four Canonical Gospels Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. On the other hand, the story of Christ's appearance on the road to Emmaus occurs only in Mark and Luke, and the account in Mark does not mention Emmaus. Our Gospel reading from Luke has enough symbolism and meaning that entire books have been written about it. One might say that we are all on the road to Emmaus. Our lives may parallel it. It begins with sadness and disappointment. Jesus sensed these disciples' unhappiness and asked them what they were discussing. "They stopped, looking downcast." Even when the Lord begins to converse with them, they have no idea who He is, even though they knew Jesus well and had followed Him. We may also fail to recognize or see Christ in those with whom we may walk, although it has been made clear to us He is there. Finally, where do they really apprehend who Jesus is? When Jesus breaks the bread and gives it to them. "He took bread, broke it, said the blessing, and gave it to them." This what we should experience at each Mass when the priest, as he consecrates the bread, says, "Take this all of you and eat of it; for this is my body which will be given up for you." In the Eucharist we should find everything from Holy Scripture. We, like the disciples who walked with Jesus on the road to Emmaus, should find joy and satisfaction and strength. And we, like they, should hurry to all we know to proclaim, "The Lord has truly been raised." It is still Easter and we have much to do.
