# MUSINGS FROM THE DEACON CAVE

## Love Like a Child

At the end of the gospel today, Jesus is giving us instructions on how to enter God's kingdom in reverse. He tells his followers that whoever does not accept the kingdom of God like a child will not enter into it. So, what is it about a child's willingness to accept God's kingdom that we might be able to apply to our own faith?

First, children are curious. If you have ever spent any time around a two or three-year-old, you have probably been inundated with the question, "why?" many times! Children are relentless in having their curiosity satisfied. As adults we tend to rank our questions in order of importance. We work on the ones we think are important and leave the rest. The problem is that we think we know what is important. Maybe we do... but then again maybe we don't! If we make a habit of asking "Why?" about our faith (and getting the answer) we will grow tremendously in our faith!

Next, children have a level of trust that adults rarely possess. For many adults, life is challenging. Over time, we build up barriers of protection so that we don't get hurt. But those barriers can also keep out those that want what is best for us...even God. We need to find ways of helping us come to know that God wants what is best for us. Just like a loving parent wants what is best for their children. We need to be able to trust our Creator.

Finally, children love to love. Children find great joy in new relationships and new adventures and are eager to learn to love others. Lisa and I have two little neighbor girls, and every time they see us outside they are so excited to tell us what they are doing. They are ready to share their joy with us even though we only interact across the fence! Sharing our love and our joy with others is a lesson we can learn from children!

So be curious in your faith, trust that God wants what is best for you, and share your love with others. Then you will be ready to accept the kingdom of God like a child!


