

DEAR PARISHIONERS FROM FATHER JUDE

Dear Parishioners of St. Bernard,

I extend to you all, peace, and sentiments of goodwill in the Name of Jesus Christ. This is certainly unprecedented times with regard to this COVID-19 pandemic. There is a very high-risk alert issued for the sixteen counties of the Diocese of Green Bay. Therefore, it is of utmost importance that we take all the necessary precautions both at home and in all places of human interactions.

Bishop Ricken accordingly has issued the following statement, “Given the recent marked high rise in the number of cases, and after consultation with diocesan leadership and medical professionals, I have decided to dispense again the Catholic faithful in the Diocese of Green Bay from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays.”

Our weekday Masses and weekend Masses will continue with our normal schedule, while maintaining our safety procedures as required by the Diocese. Masks, social distancing, temperature checks and hand sanitation are all about keeping ourselves and others safe out of love.

Following the Diocesan instructions on Faith Formation during this time, we shall conduct Faith Formation online/Virtual until such a time when this situation improves. Our Parish Office will be open for in-person visits from 8:30 am until 2:00 pm, Monday thru Thursday. Our Office will be open for phone calls from 8:30 am until 5:00 pm, Monday thru Thursday. Friday our Parish Office hours are 8:30 am until Noon. Please call our Parish Office at 739-0331 if you wish to meet with a staff member, since the Diocese has requested that we limit the number of staff in our Office at any one time.

While we battle this pandemic together, remember what St. Paul said about Jesus, “I can do all things in him who strengthens me.”
